

Server tutorial

After character creation you start in Gludio. Since the class change is totally free on the server you can change your class right away by clicking on the medal like icon at the bottom right corner.



This will bring up a new window where you can choose your desired class.



The process is repeatable, first you have to choose your first class, then the second and so on. Once you finished with class changing you can learn your skills, since most of them are free to learn it wont be a problem at all.

After you have learnt your skills it's time to get some basic gear. You start with 20 000 adena which is enough to get the paulina items from the Alt + B community board shop.

So go Alt + B -> Merchant -> Newbie Sets.

Here you can buy 1 weapon and 1 armor set based on your needs.



It's time to buff, which is totally free, there is 3 presets which are sort of stackable at the current version of the server so I recommend you to get all 3 of them.

Alt + B -> Buffer



You can use this buffer even outside of the towns if you are not in combat state, so it's a good way to refill your mana with it for example in the early stages of your life on the server.

There are also some folks all the time around in towns who selling buffs, these buffs usually not available in the community buffer.

I recommend you to look around in the Alt + B menu, especially in the merchant section since there are lot's of options in there and it's a good thing if you know where you can get the necessary items which you need.

Once you got your class changes, starter items and buffs it's time level up and farm some items for your next gear.

The server has a free type of community gatekeeper so you can travel all around. There are different section for that. Gatekeeper which leads you to any town in the game, it has 3 submenus Hunting Zones, Boss Zones, and Battlegrounds.



There are also Level up zones and Farm Zones since most of the zones in the game are untouched it's not true for the farm zones which are boosted in a way or other so you need to be prepared for these zones.

Before we go out to hunt it's a good idea to travel to Aden and get the noblesse status for free from the NPC Kadmos at bottom of the stairs.



Now it's time to go out and start gear up. There are no quests on the server right now, so you can freely roam wherever you want, but I recommend start with the Level up zones.

Alt + B -> Levelup Zones -> Altar of Evil.

Here you can farm adena, xp, and even einhasad coin, last one is only dropped by champion mobs. These mobs can be found in almost every single farming zone on the server. They have boosted stats, but their drop is 5 times more compared to the corresponding regular version of the same mob. And on top of that you will need a lot of einhasad later.

With shift + left click on any mob you will get a pop up window which shows the stats of the mob and you can also check the droplist/spoil list which is mostly accurate, excluding some special or alternate drop.



The server has an auto farm option since it's the part of the game by NcSoft.

You can create macros by Alt + R. Here you can give a name for the macro, and after opening your skill list with Alt + K you can grab any skills which you want to use for auto farming. Once you are finished with your macro you can save it. If you want to delete or modify the macro you can simply grab it and drop on the little hammer to modify or into the bin to delete it.



You can now grab and drop your macro into the auto hunting macro slot. The game will use these skills for hunting once you start the auto hunt.

There also some setting options for it whit those 4 icons near the macro. These let you to set up the target type, target range, auto pickup and ks options. But you rarely need to modify these.



There is also an auto-use supplies part which allows your character to use buff potions you just need to simply drag and drop the potions, scrolls etc. from your inventory to this menu and click on the little sack icon to turn the auto use on.

If you are finished with the auto hunting settings you can simply click on the sword icon and your character will start to hunt on it's own.

There are also some auto using skills in the game which are usually buffs from your skills or even from items. These type of skills has a little double arrow icon in the top right corner of their icons. You can simply put them on any skillbar and right click on them. Your character will use them whenever it can (they are not on cooldown and also you don't have that buff on).

And just like in the old days there are some toggle skills in the game as well, so don't forget to activate them based on your needs.

You can also put your macro into the skillbar and right click on it. From that point the game will auto use the macro, which can be used as an alternate option of the auto hunt.

Once you have like 200-300 einhasad coin you can stop farming for a little and get the blessed exalted set and weapon from the Newbie sets menu of the Merchant. You will get a nice new set, a few talisman and some other items.

In the Merchant there is a Runes section where you can buy a 30 days Freya's Blood rune which gives +15% extra PVE damage if you have the rune in your inventory. I recommend to buy a few Maphr's Rune +200% which boosts your drop for an hour, they are really cheap.

Now you can go to the next Level up zone and try to reach lvl105 there (Bloody Swampland).

Don't forget to learn your skills! Most of the skills are free to learn but there some which requires adena or rune stones or forgotten spellbooks.

Rune stones and enhanced rune stones can be bought in the Merchant at the skills section and you also can farm them in Tower of Insolance session zone or from greedy chests all around the world.

You can buy the lvl11. Forgotten Spellbook from the Einhasad Store, you can open it by clicking on it next to the adena counter at the bottom right corner of the game or somply from Alt + X menu. And craft the rest of the books from the craft menu which can be found in the menubar at the right side of the screen.



The other way is to buy them from the Merchant -> Changer -> Forgotten Spellbook menu, it's a little more expensive but faster. However I don't recommend you to try to buy them too early since they are not cheap and don't provide too much extra stat in the early levels of the skills.

You also should open your character info page by Alt + T and spend your ability points on the skills based on your needs. It can give you a nice stat boost for totally free.



If you reach lvl105 you can try the next Levelup Zone – Beleth Circle. If they seems too strong for you at the moment stay in Swampland and till you have 2-3 000 einhasad coins and some adena. With that you can try to buy Seed talisman and agathions from Merchant -> Charm menu. Since the enchant is safe to +5 for the agathions you can also enchant them. They can give you a nice boost in the early stages and later even more when they are upgraded and enchanted to +10.

Also try to look around at the Merchant for some other items, like bracelets, belts and so on. There are some cheap ones which can boost you little by little till you will be able to farm in Beleth Magic Circle. Once you are able to farm there you can stay for a while because you will need the materials from here to craft your R110 items. I don't recommend to craft R99 since it's not really useful.

You will need like 10 000 materials and 20 000 aether from this zone. By that time you will have enough einhasad coin also to buy a single R grade weapon which can be crystalized to get some crystal for the crafting. You may need to buy 2 of them in total to have enough crystal for the craftings.

When you have your R110 items and maybe even were able to craft Angel accessories and even reached lvl. 110 maybe you can go to the next zone to test it Levelup Zones -> Isle of Prayer or stay in Beleth Circle for a little more farm.

If you have enough adena you can try and buy dyes and put them on. And if you have some einhasad coin to spare you should buy some buff potions from the Einhasad Store, they may seems a little expensive at least some of them in the early stage of the game but they really worth it since they can almost double your stats.

It's also recommended to look around at the NPC in Giran near the wall and in the main square of Aden. There you can find some items which are needed in the future.

You can also try the solo dungeon in Aden at the NPC Karinia whos standing on the left side at the bottom of the stairs. Try the level 105 or 110 first so you can decide which one is fits you at the moment.

There are also some session zones in the game they are reachable from Alt + X menu or from the toolbar at left side of the screen under the craft menu by 2 icons.

You can either try Tower of Insolence for item enchant scrolls and maybe for some Rune Stones (the zone also gives lots of adena and xp). There is an NPC in the middle who can teleport you around the tower so you can go to almost any level up to 9. Each level is harder ofcourse.

There is an another zone named Fioren Crystal Prison. There you can find 4 entrances you can check all of them to see what can you find in each zone. All of the mobs drops Augmenting Stones for almost every single item in the game in all the 4 entrances. The easiest zone is lvl. 110, you should start there. These zones are also drops lots of adena and xp.

From the 4 zones 3 is untouched but the highest one (Icy gate) is boosted into oblivion so don't try that for a while, since it's a hard party zone.



There is a 3rd session zone on the server at the moment named Jamoa's Camp which is also have 4 separated sub zones but all of them boosted and have only grouped up minibosses. These zones are even harder than the party one mentioned earlier so you should go there when you are really prepared. (These are end game zones for Dragon Weapon material farming.)

From now on you should focus on enhance your items (mostly armors and weapon) to at least bloody stage. You can upgrade your items to enhanced by any blacksmith, then to bloody and supreme by blacksmith of mammon.

If you reach lvl120 and you have your items (R110 sets, weapon, boss jewels and so on) you can try to move on and check the Farm Zones in the Alt + B menu. The first 2 zones are good for adena, einhasad, artifact fragment and material farming. The 3rd zone is almost the same but way more harder and in bonus you can farm Heir's Radiance Shards here as well.

When you have your items on Supreme stage and enchanted them to +30 (remember you can farm enchant scrolls in Tol and don't forget the safe enchant for these items is +15, later you can use gran kain scrolls till +30) you can bring the items (armors and weapon) to the head blacksmith who can upgrade it even further to L grade. You will need a special item called Solaris which can be farmed in two zones: Gludio -> Langk Lizardmen Barracks and Temple.

From this point you can go wherever you please based on your needs. ☺
